Colab is a fountain of energy and inspiration of all kinds of non-mainstream art and even mainstream art. Eighties, the Guide Magazine, lived by the same fate. It is a piece that some people knew about and participated in, but still remained invisible.

Eighties is a simulacra of complete magazine sections in just 16 pages. The Directory and Calendar are sections of a page of a-day-in-the-life-of.

As information, Eighties is just a witness.
